

Exercise #3

Download Photographs to the Computer

In this exercise we will connect the camera to the computer and download the photographs that you took in Exercise #2.


Instructions: Each team will continue to share a camera for this exercise. If you don't get the chance to download photographs during this exercise, there are three more exercises that will provide that opportunity.

If you have brought your own digital camera to use in this class, you can use the time allocated for this exercise to install your camera software and connect your camera to the computer.

A. Create a new folder on your desktop and name it: ClassPhotos

1. **Right-click** on the desktop and select **New > Folder**.
2. Name the folder "**ClassPhotos**".
3. Locate the diskette included in your packet.
4. Copy the image file on the diskette into the new ClassPhotos folder.

B. Verify that your camera is set to USB mode

1. Turn the camera power on.
2. Press the **Menu** button and select the **SET-UP** menu.
3. Scroll to and select **USB MODE**. Set the USB MODE to digital camera 

If a battery icon displays or flashes red on the LCD monitor, the batteries are low. Please replace the batteries before connecting the camera to the computer.

C. In your packet you will find Handout #1 – Connecting the Camera to the Computer.

1. Follow **Steps A – D in Handout #1** to download photographs to your computer.

D. Pass the camera on to the next member of your team.

1. The next person should repeat the instructions on **Handout #1, Steps A – D**.

E. The last person to download images should delete all of the photographs from the xD-Picture Card.

1. See instructions on **Handout #1, Step E** for deleting photographs from the xD-Picture Card.
