- 4. Support your partner


### Be present








- O Practice building the muscle of being present:
  - 0 in meetings
  - 0 with challenging customers
  - **0** with colleagues in conversation.
- O Practice self awareness to:
  - 0 know when you're NOT being present
  - O notice the tendency to judge and react
  - O have a choice about how to respond

Libraries should reduce their book collections and allocate more space to community gathering spaces


Build up the muscle of finding what's right!

O Yes, And = Building






