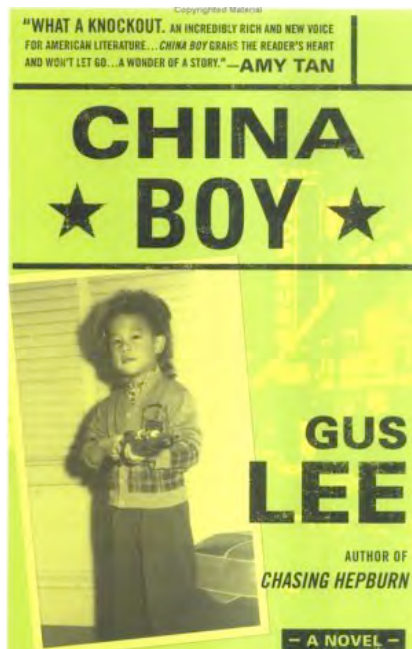
Diversify!

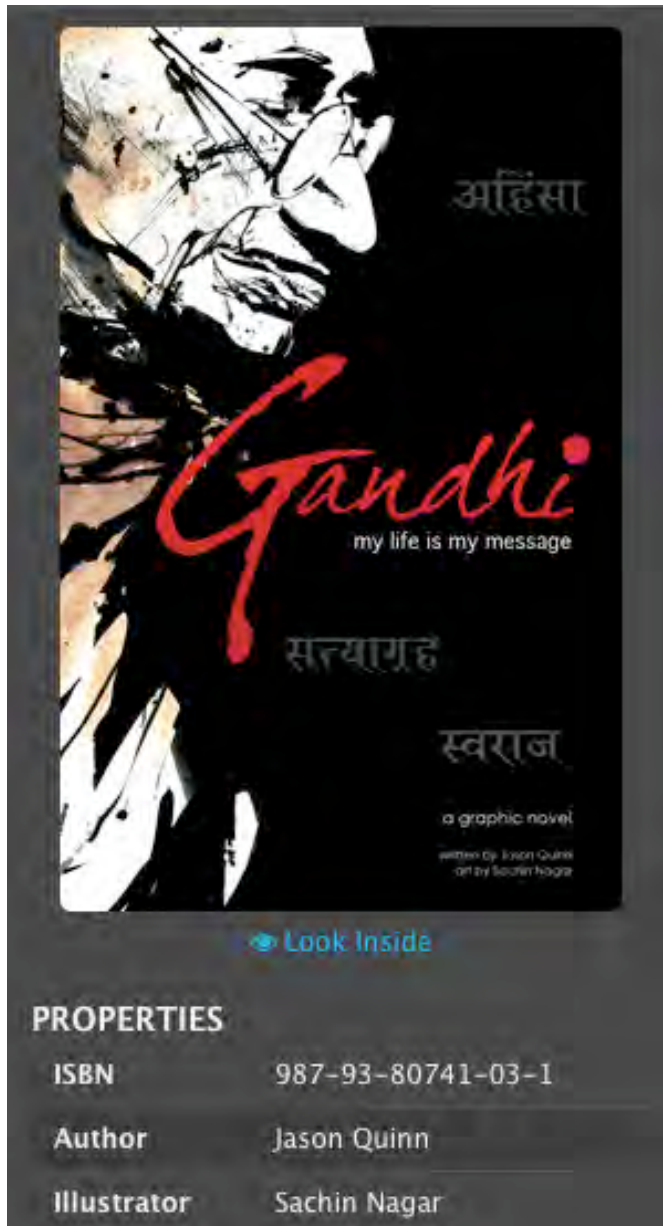
- Connect interests across formats and media

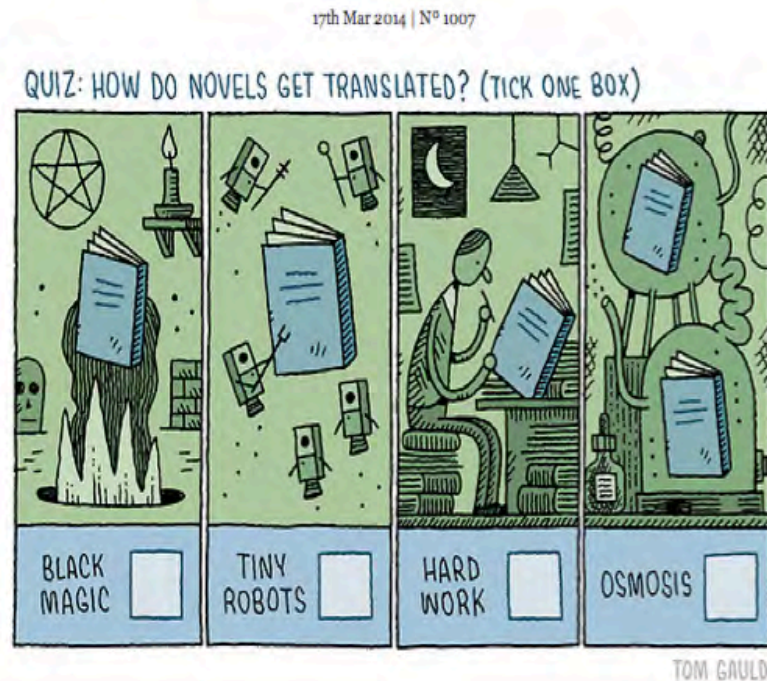
